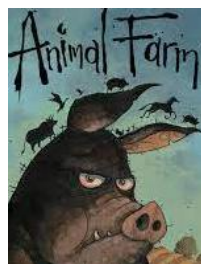

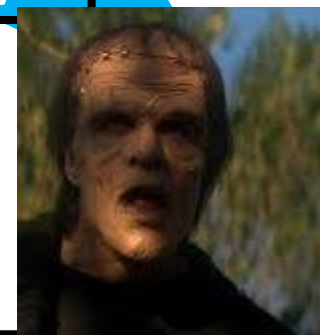

Increase the legibility, consistency and quality of handwriting

Write from memory simple sentences, dictated by the teacher, that include words and punctuation taught so far

Apply growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes both to read aloud and to understand the meaning of new words they meet

Use a range of sentence lengths and vocabulary to add interest and clarity to different forms of communication

Ask a series of questions to speculate, imagine and explore ideas.
